In 2009 we celebrate all over the world a double anniversary, 150 years from the publication of the *Origin of Species* and 200 years from Charles R. Darwin birthday. The University of Balearic Islands (UIB) launched a "**Darwin Year**" (http://www.anydarwin.cat) with several events during 2009.

One of these events will be the celebration of an **International Symposium on Islands and Evolution** that will take place from **14**th **to 17**th **September 2009 in Menorca (Balearic Islands, Spain)**. The aim of the symposium is to make a revision of different topics where insular studies had and have a deep influence on evolutionary theory, since Darwin and Wallace times to present day.

The symposium will have the support of the Govern de les Illes Balears (Regional Government of Balearic Islands), IEC (Institut d'Estudis Catalans), Sa Nostra Saving Bank, the Consell Insular de Menorca (Insular Council of Menorca), Institut Menorquí d'Estudis (IME, Menorcan Institute of Studies), the Museu de Menorca (Museum of Menorca), the Ajuntament de Maó and other regional and local sponsors.

Location

The symposium will take place at **Museu de Menorca** in the town of **Maó** (Menorca, Balearic Islands, Spain).

Scientific Programme

The symposium will include three days of scientific sessions and one intermediate day for a field trip. Each scientific session will be open and closed by a plenary lecture of invited speakers (see below). Oral communications and workshops will be organized within each scientific session, as well as poster sessions. Invited speakers are leading figures of each research field of insular studies.

Scientific sessions will be devoted to the following topics:

- Island Biogeography
- Phylogeography and molecular evolution in islands
- Evolutionary ecology in islands
